Encourage your child to make a habit of focusing on happy memories and pleasant experiences if something is bothering him in the mind. If your child thinks that a certain thing is overwhelming, help him in breaking it down into smaller units. Just because your child thinks in a certain way doesn't mean that you can't help him change or adjust that thought.

When you teach your children about love, care and compassion, it is important that you have unlocked the doors of communication. Children are best raised and nurtured in an environment that gives them full freedom to talk openly about their feelings and thinking. As a mother, it is your role to make your child understand that he can ask questions whenever

he feels like, and expect answers from you. Your child shouldn't fear punishment or anger from you if they ask something you wouldn't like or prefer them to ask.

While there are so many books, articles and other resources that focus on teaching children things like making him understand the value of money, teaching your child ways to make more money or encouraging him to become a millionaire at a young age, no one really cares how important it is to nurture these seven qualities in children. A good way to understand the importance of these life lessons is to see how the mothers of the famous millionaires helped shape the future of their children. It wasn't a lesson on money that successful moms focused on, it was rather the lessons of life that eventually helped those children become people like the US President and Tom Cruise of today. And teaching the lessons of life is perhaps, a major responsibility of every mother, whether she wants her child to be a future millionaire or not. ■

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
